



## **Certificate in Solution Focused Counselling 4 April - 9 May 2008**

### **Overview:**

This **Certificate Program** is designed for professionals who want to learn and use the fundamental skills of **Solution Focused Brief Therapy**. It is a **30-hour program conducted over 10 lessons, with 3-hour sessions** conducted in the evenings from 6:30-9:30. Participants will be able to conduct sessions in which the client's existing strengths and resources are utilized to help them find solutions to a wide range of human difficulties. Participants will be able to immediately use the skills they will learn and apply the skills in the setting in which they work.

The **Solution Focused Model** is a goal-oriented, competency based approach that draws its origins from the brilliant work of **Milton Erickson** and was further developed by **Insoo Kim Berg and Steve deShazer**. This model has been very successful in various settings, including rehabilitation centres, residential treatment centres, child protection agencies, psychiatric hospitals, schools, private practices, and in the corporate sector. It has been used successfully with a variety of presenting problems, including alcohol and substance abuse, sexual abuse, family conflict, interpersonal problems and psychiatric and psychological issues.

### **Course Content:**

Participants will learn about the history and evolution of this popular model and some key assumptions that shape what we do. They will learn the core skills and be able to conduct a first session interview and learn the steps of conducting a second and subsequent interview. They will learn the essential questioning techniques that characterize this model.

### **Key Skills:**

- Giving Compliments
- Asking the Scaling Question
- Looking for Exceptions
- Asking the Miracle Question
- Using the Relationship Question and Coping Question
- How to give end of session Feedback and Suggestions for Homework
- Using the various Questioning Techniques
- How to conduct a first and subsequent session interview

**Requirements/Advancement:**

All participants must have a basic degree or diploma. Upon completion of the course, a Certificate of Completion will be awarded.
